OBLIGATIONS OF ORGANIZERS OF IDSF GRANTED COMPETITIONS UNDER THE ANTI-DOPING RULES

Under the regime of the IDSF Anti-Doping Code (**the Code**) and WADA's World Anti-Doping Code (**WADC**) Organizers of IDSF granted competitions, under the responsibilities of the IDSF Member to which the competition was granted, have the following obligations.

1. Be familiar with the requirements of **the Code** and comply with all obligations under **the Code**.
2. Ensure that no participants and/or adjudicators take part in an IDSF competition without a completed and signed **Form of Consent**. Presentation of a completed and signed Form of Consent to the organizer is in principle a matter between the National IDSF member of the athletes and the athletes themselves.
3. Ensure that no participants (athletes) enter a competition without a proper identification and keep the identification papers ready for consultation at the competition administration during the competition.
4. At every IDSF granted competition a copy of **the Code** and **IDSF Competition Rules** must be held ready for consultation by IDSF Officials.
5. Organizers shall provide free of charge: all required information; a person assigned as a liaison to the IDSF Anti-Doping Delegate; fully equipped doping control rooms, etcetera, as instructed.
6. Make all required information available to the IDSF Anti-Doping Delegate for inspection at first request and participate actively in Anti-Doping controls as requested by the Anti-Doping Director.
7. Provide all further requirements, information and assistance as requested by the IDSF Anti-Doping Delegate. The instructions of the IDSF Delegate must be followed promptly at all times.

Please note that IDSF is always granting a competition to a member.

A delegated organizer works always under the responsibility of that member.

It's a members duty that organizers do accept and are bound by the Code.

*It's part of the granting procedure that no competition or championship will be granted to a member when that member is not compliant to **the Code** in all aspects.*
